

Mandatory travel protocols for international arrivals into Queensland

The Queensland Government has announced from 21 February 2022, all fully vaccinated visa holders can travel to Australia without a travel exemption and without needing to quarantine.

Unvaccinated international travellers still require a travel exemption. If granted, and they travel to Queensland, they will be required to complete 14 days quarantine in government-arranged accommodation.

To travel to Queensland you must:



Meet requirements to travel to Australia outlined on the [Department of Home Affairs COVID-19 website](#).



Meet requirements to travel to Queensland outlined on the [Queensland Health website](#).



Provide a [proof of foreign vaccination certificate](#) in line with [Australia's definition of 'fully vaccinated'](#).



Complete a [negative COVID-19 test](#) - PCR test 72 hours prior to departure or Rapid Antigen Test that has been approved by a medical professional 24 hours prior to flight departure time.



Complete a negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test within 24 hours of arrival to Queensland. [RAT kits](#) are available at selected [Queensland Health testing clinics](#), in retail shops and chemists.



Hold one of the following visas outlined on the [Australian Department of Home Affairs website](#). If you have applied for the visa but it has not yet been granted, you are not an eligible visa holder and therefore unable to travel.

While in Queensland you must:



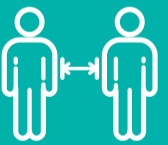
Wear a mask and follow the [mandatory rules outlined by Queensland Health](#).



Check in at venues using the [QLD Check In app](#) and show your [proof of foreign vaccination certificate](#).



Check [domestic travel requirements or restrictions](#) if you plan to travel to another Australian State or Territory.



Follow any other current [public health and social measures required by Queensland Health](#).



Get tested if you develop any [COVID-19 symptoms](#) and follow [government advice if you test positive](#).
